Gospel Partner Update: Frontline Ministries

Frontline is a mission agency that focuses on taking the gospel to difficult places. Here are 2 encouraging updates:

1) A Field Team Retreat was held in in northern Thailand - During the 5 years since the last retreat, these missionaries went through the pandemic - like everyone else, of course - except their lockdowns were longer, more stressful & more isolating than what most of us experienced here. Many of the

missionaries also experienced sickness, surgeries, betrayals, and hard questions. But they have also seen Jesus at work saving, growing and building His Church - and their families and teams, too.

Paul's words in I Cor. 16:9 remind us that opportunity and opposition come in pairs. The main speaker brought messages for those with "sore feet & thin faith." God's Word strengthened hearts to go on and finish strong. There were services, prayer times, group discussions and many conversations over a cup of coffee on the veranda. A team came from North Hills Church in SC to run a VBS program for the field staff kids. Retreats are important times to refresh and refocus and remember to "keep at it" even when the physical, spiritual & emotional demands on the frontlines of ministry are intense.

2) Filming is complete for the "Worship Round the World"
Project - We've reached an important milestone—it's called the home stretch! There's still a lot of "stretch" in this home stretch, because there are still months of writing, editing, post-production, and more details than you could possibly be interested in still ahead. But the main thing is that all of the international travel is done: 21 countries on all 6 inhabited continents over 10 weeks and 250,000 miles traveled between Tim Challies and Tim Keesee

We worshipped in 11 churches where we wrote and filmed their stories. We give thanks to God and to all those who gave and prayed and cheered us on during this glorious and arduous yearlong journey.

"Worship Round the World" is both a film series and a travelogue book. Please continue to pray for this project and the challenges ahead of us during these next months as we, by God's help, get this project over the finish line. Our primary goal in this project is to magnify Christ as we showcase His worldwide, blood-bought Family!
