*Warm greetings from Haiti!
As we move through this hot summer, we're grateful for your continued prayers and generous support. God is at work here, and we're so excited to share some recent highlights and upcoming plans with you.*



A HEART FOR THE NEXT GENERATION: We recently held a special parents meeting at Bethesda Elementary in preparation for our school's reopening at the end of the summer. The room was filled with hopeful energy as parents, teachers, and community leaders gathered to pray, plan, and prepare for the year ahead. We were encouraged by the strong turnout and the level of engagement from the parents. Many expressed deep gratitude for the opportunity their children have to receive a Christ-centered education, especially in a time of ongoing instability when many other institutions have shut down. What made this

meeting especially meaningful was that it gave us the chance to minister to parents who do not yet know Christ. As we shared our heart for Christian education and prayed over the school year, we were able to gently plant seeds of the Gospel through our words, our witness, and our care for their children. **Please pray with us that the Lord would go before every child, every teacher, and every lesson as we re-open.**

AUGUST YOUTH RETREAT: This year's theme was Trusting in the Lord Always — Isaiah 26:4. In the midst of the many challenges our youth face—violence, fear, uncertainty—we want to point them to the One who never changes. Our desire is to help them build their lives on the solid rock of God's unchanging character and promises.
