Ask anyone who knows me, and they will tell you that my heart soars and flutters joyfully when I think of God's excellent Grace! I was asked to speak at our annual ladies' regional fellowship. The key verse? II Corinthians 12:9, "My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness..." I am concerned that I want to say so much about it, I may be all over the map and unable to pull my thoughts together. Please pray with me for direction and clarity for the good of our ladies. Furlough will be short this year, July 1 through August 19. I have scheduled supporting churches that I was not able to see the last time. I tried a couple of times to get back, but my doctors would not release me for travel. What a thrill to have that permission, which indicates that I am on the mend and getting stronger all the time. Amen!

Our Easter cantata was focused strongly on God's immense love and salvation. I kept that before the kids at practice since January! They were the ones presenting the Gospel. We bathed it in prayer, and God honored that. We had about **15 visitors Easter morning.** Praise His holy name! Now, we pray that the Holy Spirit will use the planted seed to pull them toward Himself and repent.

Tristeza Church Climatization Project: I bring to you once again a need in our church. We have the largest building among our fellowship of churches, yet we are one of the last without heating and air. The fans we currently use interfere with the sound system. The building design is such that common a/c installation isn't possible. The sunny side of the auditorium is mostly glass, which causes temperatures of over 95° in the summer. With the a/c now in the basement, we held evening services down there. Cramped, but cool! The cost of the auditorium units and labor to install them is over \$19,000. Running the units will not be costly, as we have solar panels. If you wish to contribute to this project, thank you.
