GOSPEL PARTNER UPDATE:

BOB & GAYLE MCQUEARY, WORLDVIEW MINISTRIES

(MINISTRY TO CREATIVE-ACCESS NATIONS WITH HEADQUARTERS IN DANVILLE, IN)

The spring quarter of 2025 has been a productive season for us. Preaching missions conferences, reporting as well as preaching in supporting churches, vision casting among friends and new churches, the Worldview Pastor's Conference in India and a ministry trip in Turkey. Additionally, we spent time with life-long ministry partners who are going through major health issues. As we often say, thank you for your faithful prayers for our safety, energy and God's blessing as we travel these miles.

We are seeing increased governmental opposition in some of the countries where we are engaged. Satan is actively pressing godless regimes to antagonistically threaten workers, both nationals and foreign. Hostilities can include public demonstrations, visa denials, deportations, physical violence and in some countries, imprisonment and even death. Although these are desperate situations, millions remain lost. Without someone bringing them the Good News of salvation through faith in the atonement of Jesus, they have no hope. We are committed to bring the gospel message & shower people with the knowledge of God's love for them.

Recognizing that our days to personally enter these countries may be numbered, we are working on a project to make materials digitally available to national partners who speak 5 targeted languages. Here's how you can pray:

1. Pray for our new digital resource website, STUDY THE WORD INTERNATIONAL, designed especially for those ministries in limited-access countries who need theological training and materials to build churches & mentor believers. Financial underpinning is desperately needed to cover the costs: translation work, website development & maintenance. Our desire is to make these resources available free of charge.
2. Remember the ongoing WorldView translation projects in the Middle East, India and Southeast Asia and Africa. See goworldview.org, Projects & Giving.
3. Pray for additional workers to labor in difficult areas of the world. Safety is always a concern.
4. In Southeast Asia, Myanmar's ongoing civil war is a blood bath which continues to make evangelistic efforts risky and even perilous in some parts of the country. Pray for the safety and power of God upon our in-country friends who continue their bold efforts to win the lost and help supply much needed physical assistance where possible. Pray for me as I work with Burmese friends planning a future national pastor's conference.

We are thankful for your continued support.
