Jeremie & Damaris Dodeler (Amiens, France)

What great joy it is for us to know why and whom we specifically celebrate during this time of the year. What peace it is for us to know that God sent forth His Son to redeem us and to welcome us into His family. As we look back at this year, we are once more in awe of God's grace and love for our family. We thank Him for the part He has given us in His work here in Amiens, France and for the people He has led us to serve.

Here are some updates on those people:

Youth ministries resumed in September and kids returned with enthusiasm for a new season of Bible Discovery and Teen Clubs. The topics were Joshua for the kids and theology for the teens.

Ladies' and men's ministry saw increased participation and special moments around God's Word.

Praise God for new families coming faithfully. Please pray for them: **Catherine, Julette & Aurelien (believers); Soungalo & Valerie (believers from Ivory Coast); Lami & his children (returned to church); Ghislaine (new visitor).**

Marthe & her children are in a difficult situation. Her second appeal for asylum in France was denied and although the Dodeler's tried to help her seek other legal options, she has severed ties with their church. Please continue to pray.

Sebastien was mentioned in a previous letter because his father attempted suicide. Although he was hospitalized at first, he later succumbed to his wounds. Please pray for Sebastien and his family in this tragic loss. They are not believers.

Emily, a church member, needs prayer support. She recently started teaching junior high and has a difficult time with an aggressive student and an indifferent school board. Thankfully, she has seen God working in this situation.

A little excitement for **their youngest, Abel**, was breaking his clavicle in December. They are thankful for a good recovery and his ability to return to school after Christmas break.

Christmas was a special time. They praise God for good attendance at their Christmas program. The gospel was clearly shared and they ask that we continue to pray for the salvation of those who came.

They were also blessed to have Jeremie's parents, **Bernard & Bernice**, visit with them for a few weeks. They went together to Mantes, the church that was damaged last November when an adjacent business burned down. As a safety precaution, the congregation met a few weeks with a sister church so it was a special joy to be with them and back in their regular building. Jeremie preached and they enjoyed re-connecting with members there. Please pray for a national pastor to lead the **Mantes congregation**.
