## Gospel Partner Feature: Dave & Claudia Barba (US Church Planting and Support)

This December 2024 update tells about their recent ministry in Austria, and gives an update on a TX church that they helped start in 2023.

We are now back in the USA after enjoying 88 days (2 days short of visa limit) in Vienna, Austria "pastoring" an English church planted by Gospel Fellowship Association missionaries Todd and Sarah Hudson. Since 2001, God has used the Hudsons to plant a German church, now pastored by

a man who grew up in that church, and the English-language Immanuel Bible Church pastored by Todd. We will miss the wonderful believers of Immanuel who are university students, teachers, business owners, etc., who work for the United Nations, the US government, Austrian banks, and local businesses and



schools. Pictured here are the Shelton's - veteran GFA missionaries.

Vienna is a beautiful city, yet it is in typical, European, spiritual darkness (trying not to smile at or greet folks you pass on the sidewalk is tough for a Tennessean). Since 30-40% of folks in Vienna speak English, I found it easy to share gospel tracts. "Hello, I am lost. Can you tell me what country I am in?" "Do you speak English? Great! Here is my story. I wrote this. Feel free to read it to practice your English." I wish it were this easy in America. I had some excellent extended conversations with several folks. My favorite was sharing the gospel with a young lady from Greece who "never heard this before." In 1971, I was led to Christ by a believer from Greece, Tom Mahairas. Fields are white. Pray for a harvest of souls.

Claudia helped with piano playing, spoke to the ladies, and I led music and preached each Sunday morning on The Laws of Sowing and Reaping, Small Talk, Whose Music?, Take Courage, and many more. We especially enjoyed the Tuesday night Bible studies and prayer, in person at the Hudsons' apartment and streamed online. This weekly spiritual uplift included warm fellowship, Vienna pastries, and oceans of espresso. We will miss that. In Vienna, Claudia and I spent much time editing my book of 365 daily devotionals, several from each book in the Bible, each 350 words or less with about a 5-minute reading time. Stay tuned.



Three bonus blessings in Vienna included a visit with the Shelton's, our daughter Susannah, and Hungarian missionary Zoltan Kiss family (pictured left). About 3.2 million years ago, I led a teen to Christ at Falls Baptist Church. He became a missionary and planted a church in Hungary. Zoltan got saved in that

church in 1995, was in a church planting course I taught, and began his church planting ministry in Budapest in 2016. You reap more than you sow. All of grace!

Though Thanksgiving is not observed in Austria, Claudia and I enjoyed a celebration lunch at a luxurious downtown hotel (compliments of a faithful Immanuel Church member), to remember Thanksgiving Day 1972, when God miraculously put us together at the Western Family Steakhouse in Greenville, SC. December 7 was my 50th anniversary of ordination to the ministry.

Pictured right is Sand Hills Baptist in Lavernia (San Antonio) Texas. It was planted in the Fall 2023 and now averages 40-50 people with discipleship ministry, a children's service, and a growing nursery!
